

ALAN CARLSTROM, FACULTY Throughout his professional career he has had the opportunity to work as a freelance artist exploring his passion of portraiture. He handles his subjects with sensitivity while trying to capture individual personas through the use of exaggeration.

#### 9-11 a.m. FIGURE DRAWING

This course focuses on the figure as subject. Students learn advanced techniques in anatomy and proportions, the characteristics of a models pose, analyzing form and giving weight to the figure through light and dark.

#### 11 a.m.-1 p.m.

#### ILLUSTRATION AND COLOR

This course engages students in the fundamentals of being an illustrator. Work with color in complex schemes to solve visual problems, generate ideas, tell stories, and explore the possibilities of fantasy.

#### **PROGRAM OBJECTIVE**

This program is designed to assist college-bound students and others to stand above the rest—strengthening portfolios that are required in the college admission process.

#### ELIGIBILITY

This program is offered to high school students with a serious interest in the visual arts. Students with varying levels of experience and ability are welcome to apply.
